Road Restrictions- Langram Road Restrictions on August 29th from Put-in-Bay Road to Meechen Road starting at 2:30pm until 30 minutes after concert concludes (approx 10:30pm)

Gates Open- 3:00 pm (according to Bashonthebay.com)

First Act- 3:30pm

NFL Bag Policy- All clear 12" x 6" totes or smaller (policy can be found here <http://www.nfl.com/qs/allclear/index.jsp>)



No Outside Alcohol- no alcohol can be carried into venue

Everyone will be searched

Taxi/buses/TourTrain- only vehicles allowed on Langram Rd restricted areas during concert. Sheriff will be on north end of Langram enforcing speed limits

Late Night Ferry- Distance from Ferry- ¼ Mile to Miller Ferry. 1.5 Miles to Jet-express. Bus transport available for fee to Downtown Depot near Jet-Express

- Miller Ferry will run until 1am or as needed
- Jet-Express is running by reservation only. 2800 reservations to date. Possible more available day of concert.
- No Kelley's Island Ferry- Check with Kelleys Island Chamber for private charters

ATM- machines on site.

Chairs- in Section B only, bring your own.

Wifi/phone- Please print off tickets prior to getting to venue. Limited access to internet. Amplex is WIFI Secure Network Provider. No public wifi

No Readmission. No exceptions

Handicapped Access- South Gate by stage. Handicapped ticket holders are requested to call prior to concert.

Weather Plan- incase of bad weather. Rain only will not delay concert. If lightning is forecast, decision will be made ½ hour prior to predicted storm. Relocation to downtown venues is suggested. If concert resumes, WIOT-FM 104.7 is the source for public information

We had a very informative meeting yesterday with updates by Tim Niese, Rick Zebarth, Eric Engle, and Chief Riddle.

Highlights:

Tim shared with us an extensive Emergency Action Plan (EAP) that details actions to take in response to emergency or otherwise hazardous conditions.

Horses, bomb dogs, 100 deputies and 200 security personnel in and around the event will keep us safe.

The Sheriff will cover the entire Township before, during and after the event.

The Village will have 30 officers on duty.
